ENTRY INFORMATION

- ENTRY FEE:** \$12.00 Regular Classes
\$15.00 Championships Classes
\$20.00 for classes 8 & 13 (\$100 payout classes)
\$25.00 for classes 26 & 28 (qualifiers for class 51)

The top 6 placings of classes 26 & 28 are invited back to class 51. No additional class fee is required for class 51.

ENTRIES CLOSE POSTMARKED Saturday, April 30, 2016

- **Post (Late) Entries** will be accepted after Saturday, April 30, 2016 for an **additional Late Fee of \$20.00 per horse or pony** entered. Regular Fees and associated rules apply thereafter.
 - **Entries** must be made in writing, signed by the owner or authorized agent, and the trainer; and must be accompanied by funds to cover all charges. If the owner or exhibitor is under 18 years of age, the entry blank must be signed by an adult who assumes all responsibilities and risks stated on the entry blank.
 - Exhibitors are solely responsible for completing the entry blank and add slips accurately as recorded with their breed and point organizations. The Management and Staff take no responsibility for exhibitors' errors.
 - Once entered, class additions and/or scratches will be accepted **ONLY if changes made are at least 3 classes prior to the class.** Failure to ADD or SCRATCH an entry prior to that WILL RESULT IN AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$5.00 PER CLASS.
The Management and Staff of FEA respectfully request your cooperation and compliance with this rule.
 - **RETURNED CHECKS: A \$50 FEE WILL BE CHARGED ON TOP OF ALL BANK FEES INCURRED.**
 - **All Fees must be paid in full (or a signed blank check left to cover expenses) prior to issuing a number.**
 - **REFUNDS:** There will be no refunds on entry fees unless due to a bona fide injury of horse (rider in equitation). Refunds will be made only upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate (doctor's certificate) and must be received by the Show Manager or Secretary before the end of the Show to be considered.
 - The Show Management reserves the right to decline any entry and to return fees before the opening of the show and, to prohibit or remove any person or horse from the show without being held liable for compensation.

CREENTIALS

- **Proof of Negative Coggins** within one year is required for horses stabled in the State of MA and within the last six months is required for out of state horses. Please include Coggins date (month/year) on your entry blank
- **Vaccinations.** It is strongly recommended that **all animals** on the show grounds be vaccinated for RABIES within one year from this show. Other vaccinations are also encouraged:

PRIZE MONEY ~ RIBBONS ~ TROPHIES

- Prize money will be awarded in the ring by a premium voucher.
- Payouts are as follows:
\$100 classes (8 & 13): 1st- \$40, 2nd- \$30, 3rd-\$20, 4th- \$10.
\$300 class (51) 1st- \$125, 2nd- \$75, 3rd-\$50, 4th-\$25, 5th-\$15, 6th- \$10

- Once the voucher has been awarded, responsibility of the Horse Show will cease.
- Vouchers may be deducted from show fees or redeemed at the Secretary's Office **only** after the exhibitor's final class.
- All vouchers must be redeemed by the end of the Show and will be invalid after the Show Office closes on Sunday May 8, 2016
- Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes

OTHER INFORMATION

- **HOLDS** will only be permitted due to extenuating circumstances. You must fill out a hold form in the office and bring it to the announcer at least 15 minutes before the class to be held. Emergency holds will be given for broken tack, etc.
- While the show is in progress only authorized personnel will be permitted in the ring and must be properly attired. No torn clothing or barn/stable affiliation attire. No shorts or sleeveless shirts.
- The Show Committee and/or Management reserves the right to split any classes it deems necessary. It also reserves the right to cancel classes that do not meet a preset minimum number.
- Stallions are barred in classes restricted to Ladies and Junior Exhibitors, unless specifically allowed in that breed's regulations.
- **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH OR TIED AT ALL TIMES.** Dogs will not be allowed against the rail of the show ring. Nuisance dogs or dogs with excessive barking may be asked to leave. Please clean up after your dog.
- All motorized transports must be operated by licensed drivers and kept away from horse traffic areas.
- No strollers will be permitted in the chute or near the In and Out Gates
- There will be no lunging or long lining in the show arena. All lunging must be done outside of the show arena or in the warm up ring. No more than 2 horses at a time can be in the warm up lunging at the same time.
- Fire and emergency lanes must be kept open at all times. Horse Trailers and vehicle parking will be limited to designated areas
- For Championships: # in parentheses () indicates that the horse (or rider in equitation) must have been entered, shown and judged in the designated class.
- Unruly horses will be excused per the judge's discretion and the exhibitor will be refunded for only the future classes that they have entered. The office fee will not be refunded. Horses that kick should have a red ribbon on their tail. Stallions should have a yellow ribbon in their tail.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS:

SPECILATY CLASSES

Black Diamond Jubilee Pleasure Challenge:

Open to all horses and breeds. Top 6 in both classes 26 and 28 are required to show back in class 51. Class entry fee is \$25 for classes 26 and 28. Championship class is free. All 3 classes to be judged both ways of the ring at a walk, trot/jog/alt gait, canter/lope both ways of the ring. Exhibitors may show any discipline (Saddle seat, hunt seat, western, dressage, etc) Judge may ask for extended gaits, and may require backing in the lineup. To be judged on pleasure, way of going, with slight consideration to conformation, with consideration given to type of horse/breed as represented by turnout. Definition for this show purposes: Saddle Horses are American Saddlebreds, Morgans, Friesians, Arabians, Plantation, Standardbreds. Stock Horses are Quarter Horses, Appaloosas, and Thoroughbreds. If your breed is not listed, see show management for a determination.

26. Black Diamond Saddle Horse Pleasure Qualifier

51. \$300 Black Diamond Pleasure Open Championship (26, 28)

31. Mother's Day Open Pleasure Walk Trot: Open to any parent of any age. Dress requirements are a helmet and boots with heels. May be shown under English or Western tack. To be shown at a walk, and trot or jog **ONLY** both ways of the ring. Reverse at the walk. Parents that have cantered before at a show are eligible for this walk trot class. This class is to encourage fun and horsemanship! ENTER IT!!!

Halter or In Hand Division: To be shown in an appropriate halter or bridle. Entries shall be judged at a walk, trot or jog and then individually standing on the line. Emphasis shall be placed on type, conformation, substance, quality and manners.

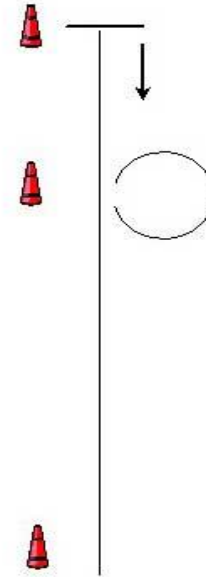

Showmanship Division: Will be judged on the exhibitors ability to show the horse in hand and completion of the showmanship pattern. 60% on execution of pattern. 40% on grooming/appearance of horse and exhibitor. Class 9 and 12 must be shown in appropriate English/western tack. Class 10 & 11 may have any discipline tack. Patterns are below. **Class 13 Pattern to be posted at the show.**

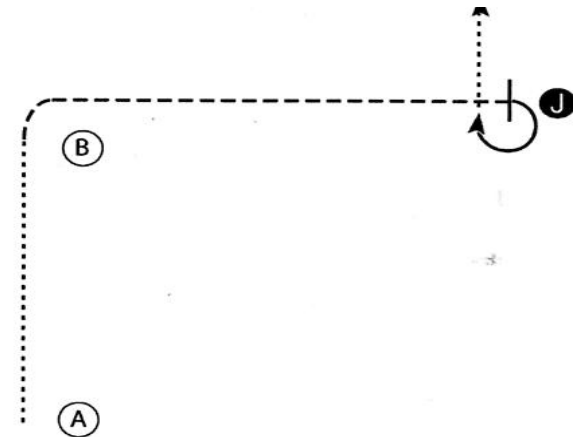
Pattern Class 9:



SHOWMANSHIP

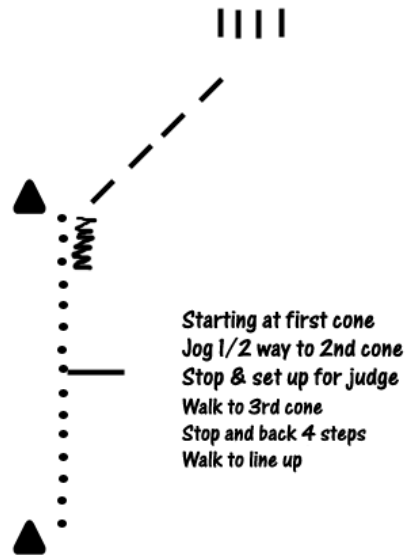
1. Start at first marker
2. Trot to 2nd marker
3. 360° turn
4. Walk to judge
5. Stop & back 4 steps
6. Setup for inspection

Pattern Classes 10 & 11:



1. Walk from A to B.
2. Trot from B to the Judge.
3. Stop and set up for inspection.
4. When dismissed perform a 270 degree turn and walk straight away from the Judge.

Pattern Class 12:



Lead Line Equitation Division: Open to riders 7 years and younger showing in any discipline. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog or alternate gait on an attached lead. Judge to look for the rider to demonstrate the rider's control of the horse/pony. Rider may be asked to turn to the right and left. To be judged as an equitation class.

14. Lead Line Equitation

15. Lead Line Equitation Championship (14)

Youth Walk Trot 10 & Under Division: Open to riders 10 and under who have never cantered or loped at a horse show. To be shown at a walk, and trot or jog ONLY both ways of the ring. Reverse at the walk. Walk trot riders cannot enter Green Horse Classes. The horse is eligible to enter canter classes with a different rider.

Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse/pony to rider

17. Youth Walk Trot/Jog Equitation

Pleasure: To be judged on manners, suitability or a horse/pony to rider and performance.

38. Youth Walk Trot/Jog Pleasure

43. Youth Walk Trot/Jog Pleasure Championship (38)

Youth Walk Trot (ages 11- 17) Division: Open to riders ages 11-17 who have never cantered or loped at a horse show. To be shown at a walk, and trot or jog

ONLY both ways of the ring. Reverse at the walk. Walk trot riders cannot enter Green Horse Classes. The horse is eligible to enter canter classes with a different rider.

Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse/pony to rider

20. Youth Walk Trot/Jog Equitation

Pleasure: To be judged on manners, suitability or a horse/pony to rider and performance.

46. Youth Walk Trot/Jog Pleasure

50. Youth Walk Trot/Jog Pleasure Championship (46)

Adult Walk Trot Division (age 18 & over) Open to riders 18 & over (as of 01/01/16) who have never cantered or loped at a horse show. To be shown at a walk, and trot or jog ONLY both ways of the ring. Reverse at the walk. Walk trot riders cannot enter Green Horse Classes. The horse is eligible to enter canter classes with a different rider.

Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse/pony to rider

19. Adult Walk Trot/Jog Equitation

Pleasure: To be judged on manners, suitability or a horse/pony to rider and performance.

32. Adult Walk Trot/Jog Pleasure

Youth Walk Trot Canter Division (ages 18 & under): Rider who has not reached their 18th birthday as of 1/1/16. Juniors may not exhibit a stallion. To be shown at a walk, trot or jog and canter or lope both ways of the ring. Reverse at the walk.

Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are required to back

22. Youth Walk, Trot/Jog, Canter/Lope, Equitation

Pleasure: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter on a reasonably loose rein, but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance, suitability and quality. Horses may be asked to back at judge's discretion

34. Youth Walk, T /J, C/L, Pleasure Open

48. Youth Walk, T/J, C/L, Pleasure Open Championship (34)

Green Horse Division: Open to horses in their first or second year of showing. The horse can be of any age. Must be ridden by an experience rider. To be shown at a walk, and trot or jog ONLY. Reverse at the walk. Backing NOT required. Walk trot riders cannot enter into a Green Horse class.

Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider.

25. Green Horse Walk Trot/ Jog Equitation

Pleasure: To be judged on manners, suitability or a horse/pony to rider and performance.

36. Green Horse Walk Trot Pleasure

Saddle Seat Division: Open to all saddle-seat riders of any age. Horses will be judged at a walk, trot and canter. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Horses to be shown in a full bridle and flat English-type saddle. Martingales or similar tie-downs are prohibited.

Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are required to back.

16. Open Saddle Seat Equitation

Pleasure: To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness. Horses may be asked to back at judge's discretion

45. Open Saddle Seat Pleasure

Open Hunter Division: Open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes. Horses will be judged at a walk, trot and canter. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. . Martingales or similar tie-downs are prohibited.

Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are required to back

24. Open Hunter Equitation

Pleasure: Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence, substance and soundness. Horses may be asked to back at judge's discretion

49. Open Hunter Pleasure

Open Western Division: Open to rides western riders of any age. Horses will be judged at a walk, jog and lope. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Horses are required to back. Tie downs are prohibited.

Stock Seat Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider.

18. Open Stock Seat Equitation

Pleasure: To be shown at a walk, jog & or extend the jog, lope & or extend the lope on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. Horses may be asked to back at judge's discretion. Shall be judged on manners, performance, suitability and quality.

42. Open Western Pleasure

Color Breed Division: Open to horses of color breeds such as pinto, paint, buckskin, appaloosa, palomino, dun etc. Registration papers are not required. May be shown under English or Western tack. Horses will be judged at a walk, trot/ jog or alternative gait and canter or lope. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Martingales or similar tie-downs are prohibited.

Pleasure: To be judged on performance, best color example of that breed & manners, on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. Horses may be asked to back at judge's discretion.

47. Color Breed Pleasure

Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are required to back.

21. Color Breed Equitation

Junior Horse Division: Open to horses age 5 years and under. Junior Horse may cross enter into other walk, trot, canter classes. May be shown under English or Western tack. Horses will be judged at a walk, trot or jog and canter or lope. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Martingales or similar tie-downs are prohibited.

Equitation: Riders will be judged on seat, hands, performance of horse, appointments of horse and rider and suitability of horse to rider. Horses are required to back.

23. Junior Horse Equitation

Pleasure: To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and quality. To be shown on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. Horses may be asked to back at judge's discretion.

39. Junior Horse Pleasure

Road Hack Division. Shall be shown on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact at a flatfooted walk, trot, extended trot, canter and hand gallop. Shall stand quietly and back readily. Shall be judged on performance, substance and manners.

Limit Rider Pleasure Division:

Open to riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons at a horse show. May be shown under English or Western tack. Horses will be judged at a walk, trot or jog & canter or lope. They shall be worked both ways of the ring and must be on the correct lead. Horses are required to back. Martingales or similar tie-downs are prohibited. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and quality. To be shown on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint.

Open Pleasure Driving

All Pleasure Driving Horses & Ponies. Drivers should wear appropriate attire. In all classes for Pleasure Driving Horses & Ponies they should be bitted in a snaffle. Open to all horses (excluding Miniature Horses) Drivers age 13 & under MUST be accompanied by a knowledgeable adult horseman capable of rendering assistance. To be shown in appropriate harness, and two wheeled vehicle at a walk, pleasure trot and extended trot. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability. Must stand quietly and may be asked to back. One attendant without a whip will be permitted for each entry. Limit classes are open to all horses that have not won more than 6 blue ribbons at a show.

Open Driving Reinsmanship

A pleasure driving class in which entries are judged primarily on the ability and skill of the driver. To be shown at a walk, slow trot, working trot and strong trot. Drivers shall be required to rein back. To be judged: 75% on handling of reins and whip, control, posture, and overall appearance of driver; 25% on the condition of harness and vehicle and neatness of attire.

The driver should be seated comfortably on the box so as to be relaxed and effective. Either the one or two-handed method of driving is acceptable. Common to both methods, the elbows and arms should be close to the body with an allowing but steady hand enabling a consistent "feel" with the horse's mouth. Drivers should not be penalized or rewarded for using one general style over another
